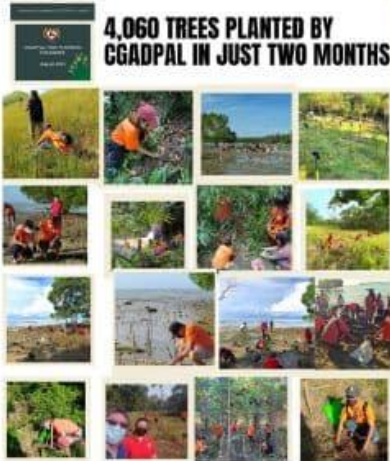

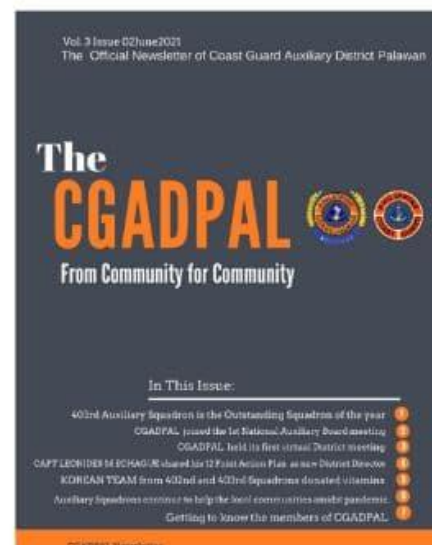

406.4th Dimakya Division helped in releasing the Sea Turtle Hatchlings in Coron, Palawan

The 406.4th Dimakya Division under the 406th Auxiliary Squadron headed by DAS CAPT EDMUNDO LUMANGOD PCGA recently conducted the release of Sea Turtle Hatchlings in Coron, Palawan.

The event started in checking of hatchling at the hatchling area which are divided into different cages based on the number of days the eggs are being prepared to be hatched. The group then arranged the hatchlings, making sure that they are ready to go back to the sea and the final part was the release of the hatchlings at around 5-7 meters away from the sea water, the process where the hatchlings release inside their way to the sea water without the help of the members. The 30-minute event was exhilarating for the participants. Sea Turtles are among the most endangered species in Palawan. Caring them is punishable by law.

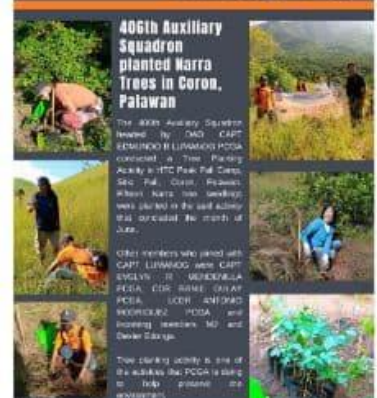
